Comments

Sadly I have not been able to find a copy of the KStN table for the Fusilier Company, reference 149n, of 1st December 1943. The detail included in the foregoing is then a reconstruction rather than a transcription. The information is derived from a number of documents, most important being the superseding table 149n of 1st May 1944. The Trains as given above is largely taken from a diagram that appears to outline the Fusilier Company KStN of 1st October 1943.

The details of weapons, vehicles and bicycles are given in the KAN (equipment table) that accompanied the KStN of 1st December 1943. There are also a few other snippets in various places that help substantiate figures for Hiwis and give the amendments of March 1944.

I will not pretend to be absolutely happy with it. I am reasonably confident for 146 of the 148 all ranks, but the final two personnel roles never feel quite right. These are for the motor mechanic and the bicycle mechanic in Company Headquarters. The latter seems reasonable, but the driver of the Company RSO possibly doubled as a motor mechanic, which leaves one post short...
